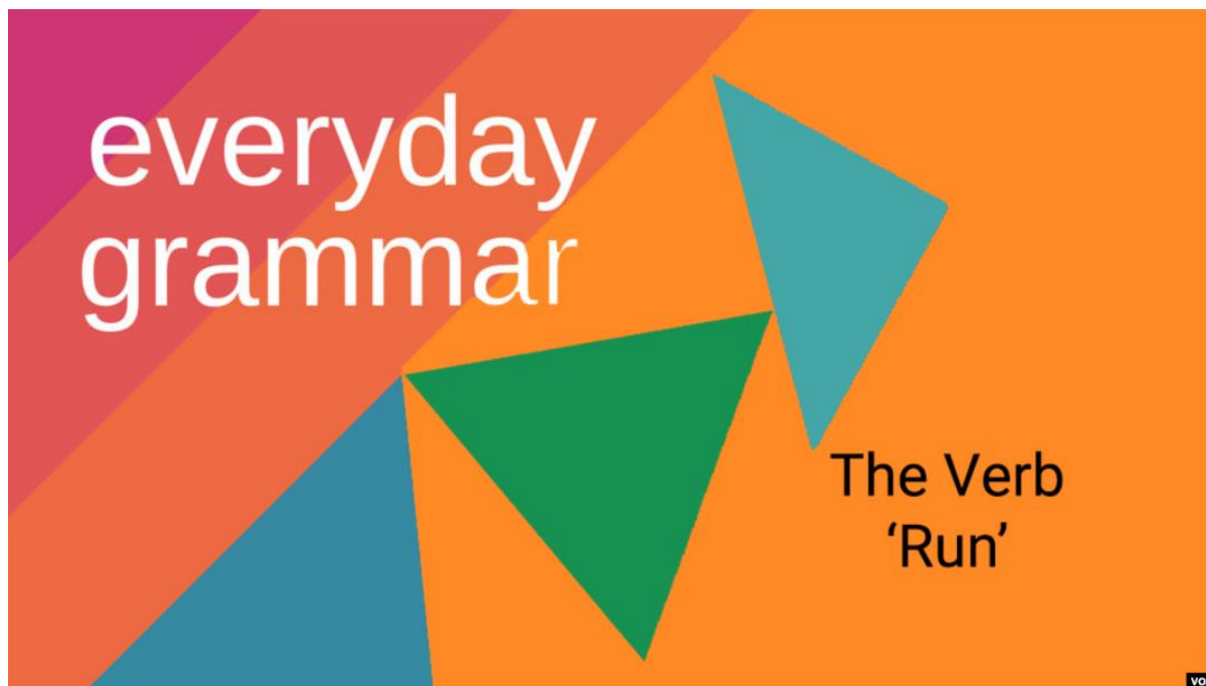


BRAIN TEASER 20
