**ferry** – prom

**lorry** – ciężarówka

**motorcycle/motorbike** – motocykl

**(air)plane** – samolot

**ship** – statek

**train** – pociąg

**tram** – tramwaj

**arrivals** – przyloty (**to arrive** – przybywać)

**departures** – odloty (**to depart** – odjeżdżać)

**boarding pass/card** – karta pokładowa

**gate** – bramka (na lotnisku)

**baggage (re)claim area** – strefa odbioru bagażu

**direct flight** – lot bezpośredni

**delayed** – opóźniony

**cancelled** – odwołany

**railway station** – dworzec kolejowy

**platform** – peron

**compartment** – przedział

**ticket office** – kasa biletowa

**return ticket / round-trip ticket** – bilet w dwie strony (≠ **one way ticket**)

**timetable** – rozkład jazdy

**motorway/highway** – autostrada

**petrol/gas station** – stacja benzynowa

**directions** – wskazówki dotyczące drogi

**travel agency** – biuro podróży

**to travel** – podróżować

**to set off/out** – wyruszać

**to take off** – startować (o samolocie)

**to fly** – latać

**to take a taxi** – wziąć taksówkę

**to catch (e.g. a bus)** – złapać (np. autobus)

**to miss (e.g. bus)** – spóźnić się, nie zdążyć (np. na autobus)

**to fasten one's seat belt** – zapiąć pasy (pot. **to belt up, to buckle up**)

**to change** – przesiadać się

**fill up the car / tank up** – zatankować
